A MESSAGE FROM FR. TIM GIBSON

I would like to introduce myself as your part-time locum priest during this interregnum.

I am a retired priest and have been living in Newcombe for four years. Originally from Sydney, I am a Bachelor of Science (University of Sydney) and a Master of Engineering Science—Traffic and Transport (University of N.S.W.) and worked in the traffic engineering field for some years before entering St. Barnabas' College, Adelaide, in 1976, to study for my Bachelor of Theology degree leading to ordination (I was there a few years before Neil Hicks). As a young adult I had been a chorister at St James', King Street, Sydney during the time when the Rev'd Frank Cuttriss was rector.

Ordained in Melbourne (deacon 1979, priest 1980), I served curacies at St Paul's, Frankston and at St John's, Toorak, and then was Vicar in Torquay-Anglesea-Mt Duneed (1982-7), Glenroy-Hadfield (1987-95), Mornington-Mount Martha (2000-2007), and St John's the Divine, Croydon (2007-2012). I was a Field Officer with the Anglican Board of Mission in Queensland and Northern N.S.W. in 1995-2000, and priest-in-charge at Grovedale-Mt Duneed 2014-2017.

As I begin with you on 5th November (but will be away for a few Sundays in November-December due to previous commitments) I look forward to getting to know you. Please wear your name tags! Generally, I will be in the parish on Sundays, Wednesdays, and one other day each week which may vary from week to week. I will indicate in "The Link" which days I will be available, but can be contacted at any time on 0412191971.

All Saints' Day

All Saints' Day, also known as All Hallows' Day, is a Christian festival celebrated by Catholic, Protestant and orthodox churches alike, and is a Principle Feast of the Anglican Communion. It is celebrated on the first of November by the Catholic and Protestant Churches, although Eastern Orthodoxy celebrate the festival on the first Sunday after Pentecost, and the Oriental Orthodoxy celebrates it on the first Friday after Easter.

Christian celebration of All Saints' and All Souls' Day stems from the belief that there is a powerful spiritual bond between those in heaven and the living. In Catholic theology, the day commemorates all those who have obtained the beatific vision in Heaven. In Methodist theology, All Saints' Day revolves around giving God solemn thanks for the lives and deaths of his saints, including those who are both famous and obscure. As such, individuals throughout the Church Universal are honoured, such as Paul the Apostle, in addition to individuals who have personally led one to faith in Jesus, such as one's grandmother or friend.

In the Western Christian churches, liturgical celebrations of All Saints' Day begin at Vespers on the evening of October 31 (All Hallows' Eve), and ends at the close of November 1. This choice of date can be traced to Pope Gregory III (731-741ad), who moved the date to November from its previous celebration on May 13; likely to remove the ties of the festival with the earlier pagan festival of *Lemuria*, celebrated on the same day.
